## 4. <u>TIP, STIP, AND LRTP UPDATE</u>

Ms. Barry began by saying that the initial DRAFT has been submitted and we await comment from ODOT of the 16 projects that we have submitted through our TIP. Comments are due back March 3<sup>rd</sup> from ODOT with our responses due by March 6<sup>th</sup>.

Thom continued stating that there were roughly four dozen different projects proposed by local stakeholders that were reviewed for eligibility. It is understood that projects are getting more expensive and financing must be more creative especially in the smaller communities. On several projects we are attempting to use multiple phases and different sources of funding including loans and grants from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC), funding from the County Engineers Association of Ohio (CEAO), Community Development Block Grant CDBG as well as ODOT Safety Program funds, ODOT TAP and the MPOs allocations. As far as public involvement the DRAFT TIP document is now making its way thru the internal committee structure. And once finalized we will take it public with on-site reviews across the County. Shaunna is coordinating with ODOT District to conduct an open house scheduled for March 15<sup>th</sup> in the LACRPC office.

# 5. DRAFT 2022 FATAL CRASH REPORT

Haunhorst began by bringing attention to the infographic showing major stats and facts taken from the DRAFT 2022 Fatal Crash report stating that the entirety of the report can be found on the LACRPC website in the Recently at "RPC..." Section. Haunhorst went on to say that we have seen a decrease in fatal crashes from last year while still seeing a general increase over the past five years. This general 5-year increase has been seen across the nation. Haunhorst encouraged committee members to read the report in its entirety and share any thoughts or comments.

Ms. Gerker made an inquiry about the age breakdown of fatal crashes and Haunhorst stated that he does have that breakdown and it can be included in the crash report upon request
