**Lima-Allen County Safe Community Coalition reports
one fatal traffic crash during April on Allen County roads**

Lima, Ohio (May 4, 2020) – The Lima-Allen County Safe Community Coalition reports there was one fatal traffic crash on Allen County roadways during the month of April 2020. During 2020 so far, there have been three fatal crashes, resulting in three fatalities. In comparison, during the first four months of 2019, there was one fatal crash, resulting in one fatality.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, each traffic fatality has a comprehensive cost of \$5,984,145. Total comprehensive costs for 2020 Allen County traffic fatalities is \$17,952,435.
