**Lima-Allen County Safe Community Coalition reports
no fatal traffic crashes during June on Allen County roads**

Lima, Ohio (July 7, 2020) – The Lima-Allen County Safe Community Coalition reports there were no fatal traffic crashes on Allen County roadways during the month of June 2020. During 2020 so far, there have been five fatal crashes, resulting in five fatalities. In comparison, during the first six months of 2019, there were two fatal crashes, resulting in two fatalities.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, each traffic fatality has a comprehensive cost of \$5,984,145. Total comprehensive costs for 2020 Allen County traffic fatalities is \$29,920,725.
