### 2. **APPROVAL OF TAC MINUTES – April 21, 2020**

#### **Motion 17 (06-23-20) TAC**

Steve Kayatin made the motion that the TAC minutes of April 21, 2020 be approved. Seconded by Jed Metzger; motion carried.

### 3. **TIP AMENDMENT – PID 108975 ALL BEAVERDAM LIGHTING**

Marlene Schumaker reported that there is a TIP resolution for PID 108975 ALL Beaverdam Lighting project that requires action. The Village of Beaverdam has requested \$283,475 in MPO Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds using Toll Credit to bring the federal

share of funds to 100% in FY 2022, in the FY 2021 through FY 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

**Motion 18 (06-23-20) TAC**

Steve Kayatin made the motion to accept the Resolution Authorizing to Increase PID 108975 ALL Beaverdam Lighting in FY 2022 using MPO STP Funding and forward the recommendation on to the TCC for approval. Seconded by Mark Droll; motion carried.

**4. TIP AMENDMENT – PID 109435 ALL SR 117**

Marlene Schumaker reported that the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has requested an additional \$48,000 in federal funds and \$12,000 of state funds be added to the TIP in FY 2021 for Environmental-RW services subphase. Marlene Schumaker reported that the total of \$60,000 be added in FY 2021 to PID 109435 in FY 2021-2024 TIP.

**Motion 19 (06-23-20) TAC**

Steve Kayatin made the motion to accept the Resolution Authorizing to add \$60,000 to PID 109435 from the District Preservation Program and forward the recommendation on to the TCC for approval. Seconded by Ron Meyer; motion carried.

Marlene Schumaker reported that there is a TIP resolution for PID 109435 ALL SR 117 that requires action. The table that the members can view reveals that anything in orange with lines through the text are items that will be removed from the FY 2021-2024 TIP. The items in grey reveal funding sources from the ODOT District Preservation Program will now be part of the funding streams for the project. Marlene Schumaker reported that funding in the right-of-way has been changed from 100% state funds to 80% federal and 20% state funds. All funds continue to be from the District Preservation Program budget. Marlene Schumaker reported that some funds were moved from the Real Estate Services subphase of the right-of-way (ROW) phase to the Environmental-RW Services subphase of the PE Environmental phase so that they could be encumbered earlier. As funding for the PE Environmental phase is not currently shown in the STIP/TIP, an amendment adding this phase is required.

**Motion 20 (06-23-20) TAC**

Steve Kayatin made the motion to accept the funding streams listed in the table provided for PID 109435 ALL SR 117 Project and forward the recommendation on to the TCC for approval. Seconded by Shawn McPheron; motion carried.

**5. DRAFT 2019 TRAFFIC CRASH SUMMARY REPORT**

Adam Haunhorst presented a PowerPoint presentation to the Committee members and stated that the crash data for the DRAFT 2019 Traffic Crash Summary Report is derived from OH-1 Reports. The data is organized spatially based on accident location. The data is then reviewed, analyzed and organized in an attempt to draw conclusions. Staff works to present the data in an easily understood format. Adam Haunhorst reported that the focus of the Report has been to highlight Allen county's performance measure driven goals which mirrors the statewide goal of a 1% reduction in all 5-safety metrics. For CY 2019, four of the 5 goals were met. Adam Haunhorst reported that there were 3,278 crashes in CY 2019 which is up 187 crashes from CY 2018. Of all of the crashes, 34% occurred within the City of Lima with the next highest crash location being in Bath Township with 14% of all crashes. Ft. Amanda and Shawnee Road experienced 78 crashes in CY 2019. The majority of the

crashes occurred where most of the traffic exists. The top 15 High Crash Intersections remain the same but in a slightly different order than in CY 2018. Adam Haunhorst reported that there was a decrease in fatal crashes with 7 in CY 2019, down from 9 in CY 2018. There was also a decrease in serious injury crashes; 70 in CY 2019 down from 115 in CY 2018. Alcohol related crashes remained the same at 147.

**Motion 21 (06-23-20) TAC**

Jed Metzger made the motion to accept the DRAFT 2019 Traffic Crash Summary Report and forward the recommendation on to the TCC for approval. Seconded by Sean Chapman; motion carried.

6. **OTHER**

a. **FFY 2021 Safe Communities Grant**

Shane Coleman reported that the Lima-Allen County Regional Planning Commission (LACRPC) was informed that the Agency was eligible to apply for the FFY 2021 Safe Communities Grant. The FFY 2021 Grant will run from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021. The Grant includes Mandatory Blitzes/National Campaigns throughout the year including Motorcycle Awareness, Click it or Ticket, Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over, etc. Shane Coleman reported that the maximum funding amount for the FFY Grant comes to \$35,000. A motion is required accepting the eligibility and enabling the Agency to apply for the Grant.

**Motion 22 (06-23-20) TAC**

Charles Schreck made the motion to accept the FFY 2021 Safe Communities Grant eligibility and forward the recommendation on to the TCC for approval. Seconded by Jed Metzger; motion carried.
