The Lima-Allen County Regional Planning Commission released for public review and comment: Amendment to the FY 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program Draft 2020 Public Participation Plan

Lima, Ohio (December 18, 2020): At the December 17th meeting of the Transportation Coordinating Committee (TCC) of the Lima Allen County Regional Planning Commission (LACRPC) an **Amendment to the FY 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and a Draft 2020 Public Participation Plan** was prepared and released for public review and comment, as follows:

- Adoption of Ohio statewide safety performance targets at a 2.0% reduction in CY 2021, and agree to plan and program capital projects, services, and programming that contribute to the realization of increased safety on the region's roadways and meaningful reductions in the number and rate of fatal and serious injury crashes, reflecting the following targets:
 - 9 fatalities
 - .75 fatality rate
 - 112 serious injuries
 - 9.32 serious injury rate
 - 7 non-motorized fatalities & serious injuries
- Approval of **Draft 2020 Public Participation Plan** which revises the LACRPC formal process to integrate increased public participation into the transportation planning process.

These documents will be available for 21 days for review and comment during normal business hours at the Lima-Allen County Regional Planning Commission located at 130 W. North Street in Lima, Ohio.
