2. APPROVAL OF CDC MINUTES - January 21, 2021

Motion 07 (02-18-21) CDC

Greg Kessen made the motion to approve the CDC minutes of January 21, 2021. Seconded by Dan Kaseman; motion carried.

3. RTA REPORT

Karen Garland reported that the Committee should have received the ridership information via email. Allen County Regional Transit Authority (ACRTA) ridership was still down in January and RTA staff believes this to continue to be due to COVID. RTA administration presented their ideas pertaining to fixed routes for the Village of Bluffton and the City of Delphos to the RTA Board at its recent meeting. The Board appeared to be enthusiastic about the new proposed routes. RTA administration will make its final presentation to the RTA Board at the March Board meeting and ask for approval for the new routes. As of now, staff anticipates beginning the new

routes the third week of June. Shane Coleman asked if RTA has received positive feedback from both communities. Karen Garland replied in the affirmative and stated that Brian has met with both officials from both communities as well as employers and the reception has been very positive.

Motion 08 (02-18-21) CDC

Dan Kaseman made the motion to accept the RTA Report. Seconded by Greg Kessen; motion carried.

4. FINAL FY 2022 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM

Shane Coleman reported that the FY 2022 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) has gone through its public involvement process and staff has received no comments. The only organizational comments received were from the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and were minor. ODOT requested changes to some PID numbers, change to an account number, correct some 2021 dates to 2022, and verify who was going to perform some activities within the UPWP. Shane Coleman stated that ODOT has accepted the document and the final version will go the rest of the internal Committee structure next week for final approval. The rest of the process is to work through assignments for Committees for the coming year, those assignments will be inserted into the document and then submitted to ODOT for its approval in April.

Motion 09 (02-18-21) CDC

Greg Kessen made the motion to accept the FINAL FY 2022 Unified Planning Work Program. Seconded by Dan Kaseman; motion carried.

5. FINAL 2020 FATAL CRASH SUMMARY REPORT

Shane Coleman reported that the Committee reviewed that draft of the document at January's meeting. Staff has received no comments from the general public. The Allen County Coroner in conjunction with the Lima-Allen County Regional Planning Commission (LACRPC) and the Safe Communities Coalition held a PR event prior to the Superbowl to release the report information. The draft document has been through the public involvement process with no comments received. Mitchell Kingsley stated that a young man recently died in an all-terrain vehicle (ATV) crash and asked if that young man's death will become part of the statistics in the next report. Shane Coleman replied in the negative and stated that the crash did not occur on a roadway therefore, it will not be counted as a fatal crash in the next report. Shane Coleman stated the crash that occurred at Eastown road and Gomer Road where two (2) persons died will be counted as a fatal crash.

Motion 10 (02-18-21) CDC

Dan Kaseman made the motion to accept the FINAL 2020 Fatal Crash Summary Report. Seconded by Greg Kessen; motion carried.

6. FINAL HARROD COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

Shane Coleman reported that the Committee received a report at January's meeting on the DRAFT Harrod Comprehensive Plan that staff had been working on for several months. The Plan was submitted to the village of Harrod prior to the public involvement process. The Village of Harrod Council has approved the draft document. Shane Coleman stated that minor grammatical errors were corrected as well as an addition pertaining to a trail that the village had

been contemplating. Staff added it to the Plan so that if the trail ever became an actual project, the data would already be in the Plan to back up the project. The village has expressed a desire to provide additional opportunities for active transportation by providing a multi-use trail for use by the entire Allen East community. The proposed path would connect Allen East K-12 school to Lafayette and Harrod. The trail would span roughly 3.5 miles north to south to provide safe active transportation to both villages and Allen East School District. Shane Coleman stated that this path would be added to the RPC Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) at the next update. Dan Kaseman asked if Harrod has considered how the path would cross SR 309. Shane Coleman replied that the path is just beginning the discussion phase and there are no recommendations that have been put forward at this time. Dan Kaseman stated that ODOT will be working on improvements to the Napoleon Road/SR 309 intersection and suggested that maybe ODOT might include the path in the project. Tom Ekleberry stated that he wanted to thank the RPC staff on behalf of the Village of Harrod for all of their hard work on the Harrod Comprehensive Plan.

Motion 11 (02-18-21) CDC

Mark Bishop made the motion to accept the FINAL Harrod Comprehensive Plan. Seconded by Tom Ekleberry; motion carried.

7. FINAL TITLE VI PLAN

Shane Coleman reported that staff has been working on a comprehensive update to the RPC's Title VI Plan which was presented to the Committee at January's meeting in a draft status. The Plan has gone through its public involvement process with no comments received from the general public or any of the Agency's immediate stakeholders. Staff forwarded the draft document on to ODOT for review and comment. Staff received one requested change from ODOT which was to change the complaint process whereby, the Federal highway Administrative (FHWA) would take the lead on any complaint that was filed. The change has been made as requested. Staff has received no complaints to date. Shane Coleman reported that ODOT stated that the document was excellent and could move on with their approval.

Motion 12 (02-18-21) CDC

Tom Ekleberry made the motion to accept the FINAL Title VI Plan. Seconded by Dan Kaseman; motion carried.

8. OTHER

a. Hands-Free Ohio

Shane Colman reported as part of the Governor's budget proposal for the next few years, the Governor has inserted his Hands-Free Ohio proposal into the budget. This proposal was one of the Governor's projects that got sidelined this past year due to COVID. The Governor hopes it will be passed as part of his year's budget. The proposal is a push to eliminate devices in vehicles. More information will be forthcoming as it is released.
