A quorum being present via teleconference, Shane Coleman brought the meeting to order and proceeded with the agenda (the meeting is also being broadcast via Facebook Live).

### 2. FINAL FY 2022 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM

Shane Coleman reported that the Committee received a report on the DRAFT FY 2022 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and the various items within the document, the reasons for the document and the ways that the staff of the Lima-Allen County Regional Planning Commission (LACRPC) tracks each of the line items within the document to be reported to the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) at the end of the fiscal year. Shane Coleman reported that the document has gone through the public involvement process. Staff received no comments from the general public but staff received minor comments from ODOT. All of the comments from ODOT have been addressed in the final document. The final FY 2022 UPWP is going through the internal Committee structure this week for final approval. Shane Coleman stated that the proposed members for the various Committees will be presented to the Nominating Committee in March with approval in April and finally, the Committees will be "fleshed out" and inserted into the FY 2022 UPWP and forwarded to ODOT.

### 3. FINAL 2020 FATAL CRASH SUMMARY REPORT

Shane Coleman reported that the Committee reviewed the DRAFT 2020 Fatal Crash Summary Report in January. The Committee viewed a PowerPoint presentation presented

by Adam Haunhorst who reviewed the "high points" of the document. The document has gone through the public involvement process and staff received no comments from the general public therefore, no revisions have been made to the document. Shane Coleman stated the report was released by the Allen County Coroner in a press release prior to the Super Bowl through the Safe Communities grant program. John Kesner, the young man that has taken over Evelyn Smith's position coordinated the release with the Coroner, Ohio State Highway Patrol (OSHP), Lima News, WLIO, etc. There was one comment made on the editorial page of the Lima News that staff has retained as part of the public participation program (PPP). This document is also going through the internal Committee structure for final approval this week. Matt Graff asked what the comment in the Lima News was in relation to the document. Shane Coleman replied that he believed that it was a part of the Editor's Roses and Thorns and stated that it was referencing the number of fatal crashes in 2020.

### 4. FINAL HARROD COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

Shane Coleman reported that staff has been working on the Harrod Comprehensive Plan for several months. Shane Coleman stated that he was proud of the hard work that Marlene Schumaker, Cody Doyle, and Adam Haunhorst put into the document. The Committee received a report on the Plan at January's meeting. The draft of the document has gone through the public involvement process. Staff received one comment which happened through the review process by the village. Shane Coleman reported that the one change that was made to the document is in the form of the following text: "The village has expressed a desire to provide additional opportunities for active transportation by implementing a multi-use trail to serve the entire Allen East community. The proposed path would connect Allen East K-12 school with Lafayette and Harrod. The trail would span roughly 3.5 miles north to south and connect both villages within Allen East Local School District as well as providing a safe and active transportation method for school-aged children." Shane Coleman stated the proposed trail project has been added to the document as this is a project the village is interested in but is not a viable project at this time. It appears that a number of people from the two villages walk along Napoleon Road and another Committee discussed the challenges facing residents that would like to walk along Napoleon Road especially at the intersection of Napoleon Road and SR-309. The Village of Harrod and staff would need to come up with possible solutions to assist residents in crossing SR-309 safely. The proposed trail project will also be added the Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) at the next update in the near future. Shane Coleman stated that the Village of Harrod Mayor and Council as well as a number of residents was very engaged in the process as well as being very helpful. This document is also going through the internal Committee structure and should be approved by the end of the week.

### 5. FINAL TITLE VI PLAN

Shane Coleman reported that the Committee received a report on the DRAFT Title VI Plan. The Title VI Plan went through a fairly extensive rewrite. The last update to the current Plan was in 2012. The draft has been out for public participation as well as being forwarded on to ODOT for review and comment. Staff received no comments from the general public but did receive comments from ODOT. ODOT stated that the "document looks excellent and appears to cover all requirements." The only suggestion from ODOT pertained to the complaint process and ODOT recommended that the document state that the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) takes the lead in any complaints. Staff has made the change to the final document.
