Lima-Allen County Safe Community Coalition reports 0 fatal traffic crashes during March on Allen County roads

Lima, Ohio (April 6, 2021) – The Lima-Allen County Safe Community Coalition reports there were 0 fatal traffic crashes on Allen County roadways during the month of March 2021. During 2021 so far, there have been 3 fatal crashes, resulting in 4 fatalities. In comparison, in March 2020 there was 1 fatal crash resulting in 1 fatality. Total for the year of 2020, there were 10 fatal crashes, resulting in 10 fatalities.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, each traffic fatality has a comprehensive cost of \$5,984,145. Total comprehensive costs for 2021 Allen County traffic fatalities is \$59,841,450.
