2. APPROVAL OF CAC MINUTES – June 21, 2022

3. RTA UPDATE

4. FINAL 2021 CRASH SUMMARY REPORT

The final crash report and stated as available on the LACRPC website. No comments were received during he 30-day comment period.

5. FINAL CITY OF LIMA COMPREHENSIVE PLAN- VISION 2040

The DRAFT of the Lima Vision 2040 plan is working its way through city government. And will come back through the LACRPC for final approval and recommendation to the city for adoption.

<u>6. DRAFT VILLAGE OF ELDA COMPREHNSIVE PLAN</u>

154 responses to the survey were received and added as an appendix of the 120-page document. It is uploaded to the LACRPC website for referrals and comments will be accepted for 30 days. After 30 days it will go through the LACRPC committees for approval before being officially given to the village for adoption. Two keys points made in the survey is the lack of public awareness of the public transportation resources for Elida and the public wants more communication and engagement with community leadership.

7. FY2022 COMPLETION REPORT

This document must be submitted to ODOT every year by end of September and it outlines all of the work that has been completed with funding from ODOT and FHWA.

8. FY2023 UPWP UPDATE

The UPWP Update is required to be completed every year and upon availability of certain financial data, updated with correct numbers. This update is the inclusion of updated numbers.

9. OTHER

LACRPC has been working with ODOT and the counties that surround Allen county to create a **Rural Transportation Planning Organization.** It will start as a Rural Planning Organization, work will take place over two years to be designated as a RTPO by the Governor. All seven counties have signed on (Auglaize, Hancock, Hardin, Mercer, Putnam, Van Wert, and Wyandot) and the resolution will pass through LACRPC committees before being submitted to ODOT.
