Staff gave the following update concerning the TIP, STIP, & LRTP:

LACRPC staff is in the process of updating the Transportation Improvement Plan, State Transportation Plan, and the Long-Range Transportation Plan. The first draft of the TIP is due February 1<sup>st</sup>, with the public

comment period taking place March 9<sup>th</sup>- 31<sup>st</sup>, and the final submission date of April 25<sup>th</sup>. There are 37 STIP projects we will be submitting to ODOT. All of which have a PID.

This TIP update has 12 projects under consideration. This does not include two city and one county project which both have PIDs and five Pavement Condition Index projects. The Long-Range Transportation Plan update conversations are still ongoing.
